Lucy Stewart and Mary Frances Park are co-chairmen of the history book committee. Lucy says the response to the mailing of 14,500 brochures has been very good. "We've had almost a 100 calls from all over the United States," she said.

More than 50 orders have been placed for the book, which will sell for \$45 before July 31. After that date, the price goes up.

Lucy said the committee hopes to have the book ready to go to press by late fall or early January 1985.
